KINDERGARTEN

The goal of kindergarten at BCCS is to help children grow in their love for the Lord and in their ability to become life-long learners. For the 2020-2021 school year, BCCS will offer full-time kindergarten, part-time kindergarten and progressive kindergarten. All three kindergarten sections are designed to meet the needs of individual students in the class as children grow into confident, independent learners.

Each kindergarten class will provide students with exposure to all subject areas and offer co-curricular classes such as art, Spanish, music, PE and more. Kindergarten teachers will focus on developing early literacy skills using a balanced literacy approach that includes the Daily Five, reading workshops, and 6 + 1 Traits of writing. Our hope is that growth in reading, writing, and communication will foster success in all subject areas. Students will also have access to their own playground, full gymnasium, imaginative classroom, active playroom, library, media center, and other educational support services.






